### HIGH SCHOOL TESTING

The PSAT will be administered for 11<sup>th</sup> graders on **Tuesday, October 10<sup>th</sup>** and for 10<sup>th</sup> graders on **Wednesday, October 11<sup>th</sup>**. The PSAT is digital this year. The exam will be taken on the Bluebook app. Students have created an account and have seen the test preview. Students are encouraged to go through the full-length practice test before the test date.

The SAT will be administered on **Wednesday, October 11<sup>th</sup>**. It will be the paper version. This will be the last time the SAT will be taken on paper. Starting in the spring of 2024, the SAT will be digital as well.
