



Timberlake Christian Schools

WHAT: Timberlake Christian Schools **Elementary Academic Resource Program (EARP)** or **Secondary Academic Resource Program (SARP)** provides remedial help for students who need extra reinforcement in academics and/or accommodations/modifications in the regular classroom.

WHO: Our resource teachers are Mrs. Debbie Hamel, Mrs. Janelle Babcock, and Mrs. Marilyn Yates. Each teacher is knowledgeable in remediation techniques, accommodations and/or modifications.

COST: **\$1206** per year for **3** sessions weekly
\$134 per month (9 months)

\$1503 per year for **5** sessions weekly
\$167 per month (9 months)

Fees are due regardless of student's attendance. Missed days will be made up if at all possible.

WHEN: Students meet with the resource teacher either 3 or 5 times per week for 30 – 45 minute each session. These sessions are one-on-one as much as possible, but may include one to two other students if area of needs are similar.

ENROLLMENT INFORMATION:

A classroom teacher or parent refers a student to the Resource Program when a weakness is discovered and is problematic to the student's academic success. The length of time enrolled in the Resource Program depends upon the need(s) and progress.

The classroom teacher, resource teacher, and parent(s) will meet to discuss the student need(s).

Test scores, classroom work, and teacher observations will be used to discuss placement.

Depending upon circumstances with test scores and classroom performance, outside educational testing may be requested.

Enrollment in the Resource Program does not ensure that a child will receive passing grades. Success is based upon the student's desire to work and cooperate with all who are involved.
