



#### LET THE EXPANSION BEGIN! - A NOTE FROM MR. ABBETT

A vision that took shape almost two years ago is now becoming a reality...we have finally received our building permits from Campbell County! New classrooms, a designated music and art room, and a special education space will provide what is needed for the foreseeable future.

The buildout is broken down into five phases with the first phase being moving dirt, expanding our parking, and improving traffic flow. We will move as fast as physically and financially possible. At this point, we have 38% of the needed funds to complete the project. The bank is willing to help finance a portion of the expansion, but it is important that we limit the amount we borrow to prevent compromising our ability to keep up with inflation, hire qualified teachers, improve our existing facilities, or put undue pressure on increased tuition. Here is what I am asking of you in the months ahead:

- Be prayerful that the Lord would provide the needed resources to complete the expansion in a timely fashion.
- 2. Be understanding as construction will most certainly come with a few inconveniences.
- 3. Be informed by watching out for schoolwide emails and newsletters that will keep you up to date on progress and last-minute changes.




#### PRE-K BABY CHICKS

## **5K, FUN RUN, & CARNIVAL**

We are just two weeks away from our annual 5K/Fun Run event. Whether you are choosing to run, walk, or simply attend, the 5K/Fun Run is a wonderful community event. The Fun Run & Carnival event will **kick off at 9:00 am** with a **5K** in the neighborhood surrounding TCS, plus a shorter **Fun Run** (approx. 1 mile around the school) for our little runners. Those interested in the timed walk/run around the neighborhood should select the 5K when registering. The shorter route will not be timed. The run/walk will be followed up by a carnival on the school grounds from **10:00 am – 1:00 pm**. The carnival will include **games, food, and more. The 5K will** 

be professionally timed again this year via chipped bibs with medals for the top 3 male and female finishers in each age group (Under 13, 13-18, 19-29, 30-39, 40-49, 50+) and a medal for the overall best male and female runner.

#### **PRE-K ART SHOW**


