## BATTLE OF THE CLASSES - FIELD DAY

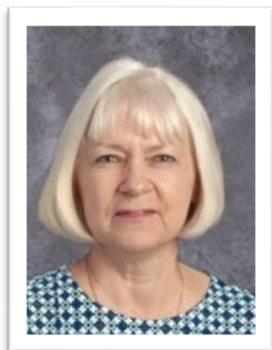
